This degree will not be completed because I decided that clearly this is not the right career for me, if it was I wouldn't have had so much difficulty in completing my education. I've since moved on and will not complete any more education in Administrative studies in any program at any level.)

There were only 2 applicants including myself so I was lucky. A 4-month student job was extended to an 8-month student job, at the end my boss had to fill out a form for my university reviewing my performance. I was hoping to gain full-time employment upon graduation but I did not graduate from the Master's degree program at McMaster and so I was not qualified for a full-time position.)

I met up with a colleague years later and he thought it was a different older full-time girl who had a master's degree already, was paid significantly more, and had a common-law spouse so was well ahead of me in life but only a year or two older in the same department who had the accident, nope it was me the single grad student living alone in a tiny student sublet.
